1.	<p>Copy of your current passport in which you wish to receive LTR visa with the validity of no less than 6 months when collecting LTR visa and at least 2 blank pages for LTR Visa and Stay Permit stamps</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The SCANNED file must include biodata page and all pages with Thai immigration stamps (ARRANGE ALL VISA PAGES, IN THE FORM OF DOUBLE-PAGE SPREAD, IN CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER AND MERGE THEM INTO A SINGLE PDF FILE) ● Fingers must not appear on the photocopy ● If you have TM.47, please upload as a separate scanned file ● You may need to upload your old passport upon request for further checks (To be requested on a case-by-case basis) <p>Note: On the appointment date, a damaged passport may not be accepted and the applicant will not be allowed to receive LTR Visa. (Signs of damage include water damage, a significant tear or tears, torn out or missing visa pages, and unofficial markings). The Immigration officers reserve the rights to refuse services if a damaged passport is observed.</p>	○

International health insurance (travel insurance is unacceptable) policy covering entire course of stay in Thailand, with coverage for hospitalization treatment of no less than 50,000 USD and the remaining period of no less than 10 months</p> <p><u>OR</u></p> <p>B. evidence showing valid social security benefits which insures hospitalization and treatment in Thailand</p> <p><u>OR</u></p> <p>C. financial evidence showing a deposit of no less than 100,000 USD (or 25,000 USD in case of dependents only) which has been held for no less than 12 months at the time of application</p> <p>Note: Must be in or translated into English or Thai language only</p> <p>If you wish to submit (A.) later (however must submit before qualification endorsement process), please upload a signed the Document Request Acknowledgement Form for LTR Application</p>	○

3.	Curriculum Vitae (CV) showing your expertise, educational and professional background related to the work assignment or position in a company Note: in English or Thai language only	○
4.	Evidence of previous employment signed by the previous employers in the related field of no less than 5 years in the past 10 years as of the submission date e.g. copy of letter from previous company Note: Must be in or a notarized translation into English or Thai language only	○
5.	Evidence of qualification e.g. copy of university certificate in Master's degree or above Note: Must be in or a notarized translation into English or Thai language only	△
6.	Clear passport size photograph (Max 2 MB) WHITE background, face straight ahead to the camera, dressed in business attire (t-shirt is not allowed) without wearing glasses or headgear, taken within 6 months	○
7.	Evidence of a full and complete intellectual property ownership e.g. patents Note: Must be in or a notarized translation into English or Thai language only	△
8.	T.M.6 Card (in case you have entered Thailand before July 1st, 2022 or entered through the immigration control at land border checkpoints and have received T.M. 6 card)	△

9.	<For employment in a private sector> Employment letter from the company signed by an authorized person which must state the current position, termination date of employment (if any) and the permission for an applicant to work remotely from Thailand or any countries. The letter must be issued no more than 3 months from the submission date. Note: Must be in or translated into English or Thai language only	○
10.	Individual income tax return such as P.N.D. 90/91, BIR60, Form 1040, SA100, T1 General etc. showing income of no less than 80,000 or 40,000 USD per year in the past 2 years Note: Must be in or a notarized translation into English or Thai language only	○
11.	An audited corporate's annual financial statement or financial report showing the company's revenue of more than 150 million USD in the last 3 years OR Evidence of listing in stock exchange Note: Must be in or translated into English or Thai language only	○
12.	Employment contract or service contract with an overseas company signed by an authorized person which states details of employment e.g. position, contract term and income Note: Must be in or translated into English or Thai language only	○
